
"For the 15 years I've been here we've had to use classroom chairs and tables to create whatever set we need in our lessons, but with the PTFA's support we were able to buy a class set of rehearsal cubes (1m square wooden cubes) that students can now use to build

simple sets and let their imaginations take flight. We've even used them to build the set for our recent Year 11 exam show. We could never have afforded them without the PTFA's help as they cost more than our entire annual budget"

The PE Department

The CNC Router has helped enhance the curriculum!

"You may be aware that at the end of the summer term we invested in a Microrouter with help of funding from the PTFA (with much thanks). A tool specifically used for engraving sheet materials.

We bought this specifically to add capacity into our T&L of high level skills in the designing and manufacture of in house electronic circuit boards; as we cannot photoetch this is an appropriate alternative. After much tinkering, I can announce that we have developed our T&L workflow from system design to electronic circuit design through to PCB layout design. This alone will give the

opportunity for students to engage in meaningful engineering at the highest level whilst being inclusive. Our Key Stage 3 PCB's will also be manufactured using this process so that students will no longer be expected to struggle with the soldering boards we are currently using.

We are offering this now out to our current year 11's to design and manufacture with independence and 10's as we move towards designing in the next week. We are currently also developing our KS3 outcomes in this specialism." The DT Department

How do we decide what to fund?

- Each year we ask subject leaders to give us a 'wish list' of items costing £100
 & £1000.
- Ad hoc requests are also made throughout the school year, from teachers, the librarian, the schools SEND department, the Finance Manager & the year 11 prom committee.
- Due to limited funds we cannot fund every request.
- The PTFA choose items which we believe will have a positive impact on as many students and subject areas as possible.
- We always consider our responsibility to the school community when spending PTFA funds, so some requests are instant nos!

Current funding requests:

An all weather shelter -up to £20,000:

The school's finance manager has asked the PTFA to help raise funds for an outdoor shelter.

Currently the school has a large amount of outdoor space, but not enough

sheltered areas.

An all -weather shelter will give students more opportunity to get away from their desks at break & lunch times. Allowing them a space to shelter from light rain or extreme sun.

Current funding requests cont...

£1000 Requests:

Maths	7 x Visualisers	
Art	Wacom Tablets & Pens	To connect to the departments computers so KS4 Art & Photography can incorporate digital art, drawing & editing into their work. This will help ensure they are not disadvantaged by a lack of technology.
PE	 Equipment to include: New Age Boccia Indoor Kurling Paddle Ball Goal Ball 	Used to create a lunchtime club for students with additional needs. Whilst this equipment is expensive, the PE Department feel it would be invaluable for these students to feel more confident in PE & potentially impact attendance on PE days.
